

Charge Nurse Positions Available at Advantage Behavioral Health Systems' Behavioral Health Crisis Center

Advantage is looking for Charge Nurses to oversee services and staff in our Behavioral Health Crisis Center, located at the Advantage Pavilion for Behavioral Health in Athens, GA. The Behavioral Health Crisis Center is made up of a Crisis Walk-In Center, Temporary Observation Unit, and Crisis Stabilization Unit serving adults experiencing behavioral health crises and/or in need of detoxification from substances.

Crisis Walk-In Center: a walk in center that provides short-term, 24/7, psychiatric/substance related crisis evaluation and brief intervention services to support individuals in crisis

Temporary Observation Unit: an 8 bed facility-based program that provides a physically secure and medically safe environment to further assess, stabilize and refer clients to the next appropriate level of care

Crisis Stabilization Unit: a 30-bed, short-term crisis residential unit providing treatment to adults experiencing behavioral health crisis or in need of withdrawal management from substances

POSITIONS AVAILABLE:

Charge Nurse-2 positions

The Charge Nurse oversees services provided to clients at the BHCC. This includes ensuring safety of clients and staff, provision of quality care, and accountability of nursing and paraprofessional staff. The Charge Nurse may perform nursing assessments, develop initial nursing treatment plan, provides supportive counseling, administer medications, provides crisis intervention services, and ensures that nursing care is provided per prescriber orders. Supervise shift staff.

Shifts:

- 7PM-7AM
- 3 shifts per week
- Weekend coverage needed (options include one consistent weekend charge nurse or the two positions can each cover two weekends per month)

Qualifications:

Bachelor's degree in nursing from an accredited college or university OR Associate's degree in nursing from an accredited college or university AND current Georgia license as a Registered Professional Nurse.

Three years of experience as Charge Nurse.

Preferred Qualifications - External:

One year of nursing experience.

Experience working in a behavioral health facility or with behavioral health clients
