BHCC Clinician

Position summary: Clinicians work in a Behavioral Health Crisis Center (BHCC), completing crisis evaluations and/or behavioral health assessments to make determinations about treatment needs. Clinician will assess for potential of high risk and for need for admission to temporary observation, crisis stabilization or hospitalization. BHCC clinician will collaborate with prescribers and other specialists to develop and implement treatment and intervention programs that are client-centered and collaborative.

Duties and Responsibilities:

The BHCC Clinician will provide crisis assessment/evaluation services to determine appropriate level of care. The Clinician will provide ongoing assessment, treatment planning and interventions, and discharge planning to clients admitted to care. Clinicians may provide individual and family therapy and will collaborate with various referral agencies including DFACS, Juvenile Courts, and Schools. Other pertinent or weekly duties include

- Completing authorizations for services provided through the electronic health record
- Documenting assessment and assessment outcomes, treatment interventions , and treatment progress
- Completing discharge paperwork and safety plans for clients released from MH services

Minimum Qualifications:

Candidate must have at least a Master’s Degree from an accredited educational institution in Psychology, Social Work, or Community Counseling AND an active LPC, LCSW or Psychologist license in the state of Georgia. Will consider associate licensed clinicians for these positions, with adequate experience. The candidate must also have at least 2 years of related experience and/or training in behavioral health, working with clients and families, case management, or community/in-home based services; experience with administering Individual Service Plans (ISPs)/treatment plans; and familiarity with clinical terminology.

Preferred Qualifications: Individuals with experience in crisis evaluation and de-escalation techniques
